AN ACT

- 1 Designating a portion of State Route 279 in Allegheny County as 2 the State Police Cpl. Joseph R. Pokorny Memorial Highway.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. State Police Cpl. Joseph R. Pokorny Memorial
- 6 Highway.
- 7 (a) Findings.--Cpl. Joseph R. Pokorny, a 22-year veteran of
- 8 the Pennsylvania State Police, died tragically in the line of
- 9 duty in Carnegie on December 12, 2005.
- 10 (b) Designation.--The portion of State Route 279, segment
- 11 number 5, offset 1875, in Carnegie Borough, Allegheny County,
- 12 shall be designated the State Police Cpl. Joseph R. Pokorny
- 13 Memorial Highway.
- 14 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 15 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 16 traffic in both directions.
- 17 Section 2. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
