## AN ACT

- Repealing the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), 2 entitled "An act establishing a uniform construction code; 3 imposing powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; 5 imposing penalties; and making repeals." 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: The act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), 8 Section 1. known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, is repealed: 10 Section 2. The Secretary of Labor and Industry shall 11 transmit a notice for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin 12 when the secretary is satisfied that all of the following have 13 been enacted: 14 The addition of sections 2, 3, 3.1, 3.2, 3.6(a), 15 (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f)(1)(ii) and (iii) and (2), 4, 4.1, 4.2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of the act of April 27, 16 1927 (P.L.465, No.299), referred to as the Fire and Panic 17 Act. 18
- 19 (2) The reenactment of the act of May 2, 1929 (P.L.1518,

- 1 No.452), referred to as the Elevator Regulation Law.
- 2 (3) The reenactment of the act of September 1, 1965
- 3 (P.L.459, No.235), entitled, as amended, "An act requiring
- 4 that certain buildings and facilities adhere to certain
- 5 principles, standards and specifications to make the same
- 6 accessible to and usable by persons with physical handicaps,
- 7 and providing for enforcement."
- 8 (4) The reenactment of the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.919,
- 9 No.170), entitled "An act providing for the approval or
- disapproval of applications for a permit relating to the
- 11 construction or maintenance of improvements to real estate."
- 12 (5) The reenactment of the act of December 15, 1980
- 13 (P.L.1203, No.222), known as the Building Energy Conservation
- 14 Act.
- 15 (6) The reenactment of the act of December 17, 1990
- 16 (P.L.742, No.185), entitled "An act providing for restrooms
- in facilities where the public congregates; and requiring
- that restroom facilities be provided for women on an
- 19 equitable basis."
- 20 (7) The reenactment of the act of December 19, 1990
- 21 (P.L.1387, No.214), known as the Dry Cleaning Law.
