AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 6, 1941 (P.L.861, No.323), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act to create a uniform and exclusive system 3 for the administration of parole in this Commonwealth; providing state probation services; establishing the 5 'Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole'; conferring and 6 defining its jurisdiction, duties, powers and functions; 7 including the supervision of persons placed upon probation 8 and parole in certain designated cases; providing for the method of appointment of its members; regulating the 9 appointment, removal and discharge of its officers, clerks 10 11 and employes; dividing the Commonwealth into administrative 12 districts for purposes of probation and parole; fixing the salaries of members of the board and of certain other 13 14 officers and employes thereof; making violations of certain 15 provisions of this act misdemeanors; providing penalties 16 therefor; and for other cognate purposes, and making an 17 appropriation, "further providing for supervision by county 18 probation and parole officers.

- 2 (7) It is not the intent of the General Assembly to
- 3 authorize officers or law enforcement officers to conduct
- 4 personal or property searches for the sole purpose of
- 5 <u>harassment</u>.
- 6 (8) An inmate who is eliqible for release on parole from an
- 7 offense under 18 Pa.C.S. Pt. II Art. B (relating to offenses
- 8 <u>involving danger to the person</u>) or Ch. 61 (relating to firearms
- 9 <u>and other dangerous articles) must agree in writing to be</u>
- 10 <u>subject to search or seizure by an officer or law enforcement</u>
- 11 officer at any time, with or without a search warrant and with
- 12 or without cause.
- 13 (9) An officer or law enforcement officer may conduct a
- 14 personal or property search of an inmate released on parole from
- 15 an offense under 18 Pa.C.S. Pt. II Art. B or Ch. 61 without a
- 16 <u>warrant and without cause</u>.
