AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting certain drivers from using mobile phones.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 3316. Prohibiting use of mobile phones.
9	(a) Drivers subject to restrictionsNo driver with a
10	<u>learner's permit or junior driver's license shall drive a motor</u>
11	vehicle on a highway in this Commonwealth, including Federal,
12	State and municipal highways, while using a mobile phone.
13	(b) ExceptionsThis section shall not apply to persons who
14	use a mobile phone for the sole purpose of reporting an accident
15	or emergency.
16	(c) SeizureThe provisions of this section shall not be
17	construed as authorizing the seizure or forfeiture of a mobile

1 phone, unless otherwise provided by law.

2 (d) Penalty. -- A person who violates subsection (a) commits a 3 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$1 nor more than \$300 or to a period of 4 community service to be determined by the sentencing authority. 5 (e) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following 6 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 7 8 subsection: "Hands-free mobile telephone." A telecommunications device 9 that receives an analog signal or digital signal, or both, and 10 11 is designed for use without being held by a person's hand while 12 speaking into the device. 13 "Mobile phone." A telecommunications device that receives an analog signal or digital signal, or both, and that is designed 14 for handheld use, or a hands-free mobile telephone. 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in six months. 16
