## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for
- 3 subpoena.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6333 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 6333. Subpoena.
- 9 Upon application of a child, parent, guardian, custodian,
- 10 probation officer, district attorney, or other party to the
- 11 proceedings, the court, master, or the clerk of the court shall
- 12 issue, or the court or master may on its own motion issue,
- 13 subpoenas requiring attendance and testimony of witnesses and
- 14 production of papers at any hearing under this chapter. A copy
- 15 of the subpoena requiring attendance and testimony of a witness
- 16 who is under 18 years of age shall be issued to the parent,
- 17 guardian or other custodian of the witness in addition to the

- 1 <u>issuance of the subpoena for the witness.</u>
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
