8	§ 6310.4. Restriction of operating privileges.
9	(a) General ruleWhenever a person is convicted or is
10	adjudicated delinquent or is admitted to any preadjudication
11	program for a violation of section 6307 (relating to
12	misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or brewed
13	beverages), 6308 (relating to purchase, consumption, possession
14	or transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages), 6310.1
15	(relating to selling or furnishing liquor or malt or brewed
16	beverages to minors) or 6310.3 (relating to carrying a false

identification card), the court, including a court not of record if it is exercising jurisdiction pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 1515(a) (relating to jurisdiction and venue), shall order the operating privilege of the person suspended. A copy of the order shall be transmitted to the Department of Transportation. * * *

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
