## AN ACT

14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Section 2006 of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682,
16	No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended
17	by adding paragraphs to read:
18	Section 2006. Proper Notification of Intention to CancelA
19	cancellation or refusal to renew by an insurer of a policy of
20	automobile insurance shall not be effective unless the insurer
21	delivers or mails to the named insured at the address shown in

1 the policy a written notice of the cancellation or refusal to 2 renew. The notice shall:

4	(8) Advise the insured that, in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S. §
5	<u>1786(g)(2) (relating to required financial responsibility), no</u>
6	person shall be penalized for maintaining a registered motor
7	vehicle without financial responsibility under 75 Pa.C.S. §
8	<u>1786(d) if at the time the insurance coverage is terminated or</u>
9	financial responsibility lapsed, the registration plate and card
10	were voluntarily surrendered to the Department of
11	Transportation.
12	(9) Advise the insured that, in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S. §
13	1786(d), if the policy is cancelled or not renewed and
14	subsequent policy is not immediately issued, the insured will be
15	subject to a three-month suspension of registration and
16	operating privileges, will be required to surrender the
17	registration plate and card to the Department of Transportation
18	and will be subject to the penalties provided under 75 Pa.C.S. §
19	<u>1786(f).</u>
20	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
