4 COUNTY, AS THE SENATOR ROGER A. MADIGAN HIGHWAY; DESIGNATING
5 THE BRIDGE ON STATE ROUTE 655 ON MAIN STREET, BELLEVILLE,
6 UNION TOWNSHIP, MIFFLIN COUNTY, AS THE CURT ZOOK MEMORIAL
7 BRIDGE; DESIGNATING THE NEWTOWN 413 BYPASS AS THE OFFICER
8 GREGG MEMORIAL BYPASS; AND DESIGNATING THE WALNUT STREET
9 BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY, AS THE
10 MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 ~~Section 1. Veterans' Memorial Bridge.~~ <—

14 ~~(a) Designation. The bridge joining Clearfield and Centre~~
15 ~~Counties on State Route 322 is designated and shall be known as~~
16 ~~the Veterans' Memorial Bridge.~~

17 ~~(b) Signs. The Department of Transportation shall erect and~~
18 ~~maintain appropriate signs which shall display the name of the~~

1 ~~bridge designated in subsection (a) at each end of the bridge~~
2 ~~and at the sides of the bridge so that persons traveling on~~
3 ~~State Route 322 can see the designation referred to in~~
4 ~~subsection (a).~~

8 SECTION 1. SENATOR ROGER A. MADIGAN HIGHWAY.

9 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE NEW SECTION OF US ROUTE 15, OPENED ON
10 OCTOBER 1, 2008, AND BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION WITH STATE
11 ROUTE 287 IN TIOGA TOWNSHIP, TIOGA COUNTY, AND EXTENDING TO THE
12 STATE LINE WITH NEW YORK, IS DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS
13 THE SENATOR ROGER A. MADIGAN HIGHWAY.

14 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
15 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS WHICH SHALL DISPLAY THE NAME OF THE
16 HIGHWAY DESIGNATED IN SUBSECTION (A) AT EACH END.

17 SECTION 2. CURT ZOOK MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

18 (A) DECLARATION OF POLICY.--THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND
19 DECLARES AS FOLLOWS:

20 (1) CHARLES CURTIS ZOOK'S DEDICATION AND SERVICE TO HIS
21 COMMUNITY LED TO THE FORMATION OF VILLAGE PRIDE IN FEBRUARY
22 1998. AS CHAIRMAN OF PROJECT IMPACT, A SUB-COMMITTEE OF
23 VILLAGE PRIDE, MR. ZOOK ORCHESTRATED THE IMPROVEMENT OF
24 DOWNTOWN BELLEVILLE TO LESSEN THE FLOOD DAMAGE AND EROSION ON
25 THE KISHACOQUILLAS CREEK. THOUGH A TREMENDOUS VOLUNTEER
26 EFFORT, MR. ZOOK AND THE ASSOCIATION RECEIVED OVER \$780,000
27 IN GRANT FUNDING TO ENLARGE THE CREEK'S FLOOD PLAIN, PROVIDE
28 OPEN SPACE AND EXPAND THE BRIDGE THAT WILL NOW HONOR HIM AND
29 FURTHER PROTECT THE COMMUNITY FROM FUTURE FLOODING; AND

30 (2) BORN IN BELLEVILLE, MIFFLIN COUNTY, MR. ZOOK

1 GRADUATED FROM MERCERSBURG ACADEMY, ATTENDED LAFAYETTE
2 COLLEGE AND SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES MARINES DURING THE
3 KOREAN WAR;

4 (3) MR. ZOOK WAS MARRIED TO PATRICIA WOMELDORF ZOOK AND
5 HAD THREE DAUGHTERS, LISA, LAURIE, AND LETITIA; AND

6 (4) AFTER HIS MILITARY SERVICE, MR. ZOOK WAS PRESIDENT
7 OF KA-VEE DAIRY, FOUNDED BY HIS FATHER AND ALSO WORKED FOR
8 KEYSTONE FOOD SERVICE, WOMELDORF TRUCKING COMPANY AND RICH
9 COAST COFFEE COMPANY; AND

10 (5) MR. ZOOK WAS A MEMBER OF THE BELLEVILLE LIONS CLUB,
11 LEWISTOWN ROTARY CLUB, MARINE CORP LEAGUE, KA-VEE KAMP AND
12 WEST KISHACOQUILLAS PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, AND SERVED ON THE
13 VILLAGE PRIDE ASSOCIATION AND MIFFLIN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL
14 DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION; AND

15 (6) CHARLES CURTIS ZOOK DIED ON JULY 16, 2008, AT 79
16 YEARS OF AGE.

17 (B) DESIGNATION.--THE STATE ROUTE 655 BRIDGE ON MAIN STREET
18 IN UNION TOWNSHIP, MIFFLIN COUNTY IS DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE
19 KNOWN AS THE CURT ZOOK MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

20 (C) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
21 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS WHICH SHALL DISPLAY THE NAME OF THE
22 BRIDGE DESIGNATED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) AT EACH END OF THE
23 BRIDGE.

24 SECTION 3. OFFICER GREGG MEMORIAL BYPASS.

25 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE SECTION OF STATE ROUTE 413 IN NEWTOWN
26 TOWNSHIP, BUCKS COUNTY, FROM THE INTERSECTION WITH STATE ROUTE
27 532 TO THE INTERSECTION WITH INTERSTATE 95, KNOWN LOCALLY AS THE
28 NEWTOWN 413 BYPASS, IS DESIGNATED AND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE
29 OFFICER GREGG MEMORIAL BYPASS.

30 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND

1 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS WHICH SHALL DISPLAY THE NAME OF THE
2 BYPASS DESIGNATED IN SUBSECTION (A) AT EACH END.

3 SECTION 4. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

4 (A) DESIGNATION.--THE BRIDGE LOCATED ON WALNUT STREET, CITY
5 OF JOHNSTOWN, CAMBRIA COUNTY, KNOWN AS THE WALNUT STREET BRIDGE,
6 IS HEREBY DESIGNATED THE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., MEMORIAL
7 BRIDGE.

8 (B) SIGNS.--THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL ERECT AND
9 MAINTAIN APPROPRIATE SIGNS DISPLAYING THE NAME OF THE BRIDGE TO
10 TRAFFIC IN BOTH DIRECTIONS ON THE BRIDGE.

11 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
