AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1944, No.655), 2 entitled "An act providing a permanent allocation of a part of the fuels and liquids fuels tax proceeds to cities, 3 4 boroughs, incorporated towns and townships, for their road, 5 street and bridge purposes; conferring powers and imposing duties on local officers and the Department of Highways; and making an appropriation out of the Motor License Fund; and 7 repealing existing legislation," increasing the amount of the 8 9 municipal allocation that may be used to purchase road equipment. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 4(1) of the act of June 1, 1956 (1955) 13 14 P.L.1944, No.655), referred to as the Liquid Fuels Tax Municipal Allocation Law, amended November 23, 2004 (P.L.944, No.138), is 16 amended to read: 17 Section 4. - 6 Where road, bridge, alley, way or court work is performed by the
- 7 political subdivision the moneys herein allocated may be used
- 8 only for labor, hiring of equipment, payrolls, purchase of
- 9 material, including repair parts necessary for the maintenance
- 10 of equipment, small tools, road drags and snow fences and, in
- 11 addition, an amount not to exceed [twenty] thirty per centum of
- 12 the total annual allocation received by each municipality, may
- 13 be used for the purchase of road machinery and road equipment;
- 14 and (iv) for the acquisition of computer-related hardware,
- 15 software and training required for the electronic processing of
- 16 information concerning the funds appropriated and allocated
- 17 under this act, including the preparation and electronic
- 18 submission of the required annual reports for payment
- 19 certification, provided that expenditures under this subclause
- 20 may not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) annually.
- 21 No municipality shall receive less than the amount allocated
- 22 to such municipality during the fiscal year ending June 30,
- 23 1969. So much as is necessary of the taxes collected on each
- 24 gallon of liquid fuel under "The Liquid Fuel Tax Act" and on
- 25 each gallon of fuel under the "Fuel Use Tax Act" is hereby
- 26 appropriated out of the Motor License Fund to municipalities of
- 27 the Commonwealth for the purpose of making any additional
- 28 payments required under the provisions hereof. Funds hereby
- 29 appropriated shall be in addition to funds appropriated under
- 30 the provisions of section 3 of this act.

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- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
