## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of sale or transfer of firearms.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 6111(g) (4) of Title 18 of the
Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms.

(g) Penalties.--

*     *         * 

(4) Any person, purchaser or transferee [who] commits a felony of the third degree if, in connection with the purchase, delivery or transfer of a firearm under this chapter, he knowingly and intentionally:
(i) makes any materially false oral [or written
statement or] statement;
(ii) makes any materially false written statement,
including a statement on any form promulgated by Federal
or State agencies; or
(iii) willfully furnishes or exhibits any false
identification intended or likely to deceive the seller,
licensed dealer or licensed manufacturer [commits a
felony of the third degree].
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
