## AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation from the General Fund to the Department
- of Health for the purpose of funding a grant for antibiotic
- 3 research and development to find a cure for streptococcus
- 4 pneumonias for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2008.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The sum of \$5,000,000 is hereby appropriated to
- 8 the Department of Health for the fiscal year July 1, 2008, to
- 9 June 30, 2009, for a grant to fund antibiotic research and
- 10 development to find a cure for streptococcus pneumonias, also
- 11 known as "the superbug."
- 12 Section 2. The grant shall be awarded by competitive bid to
- 13 a nonprofit health research institute located within this
- 14 Commonwealth.
- 15 Section 3. Award of the grant shall be decided by the
- 16 Secretary of Health.
- 17 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008, or

1 immediately, whichever is later.
