AN ACT

Amending the act of May 2, 1947 (P.L.143, No.62), entitled "An act regulating the sale and resale for profit and the 2 3 carrying on of the business of selling or reselling tickets or other devices for admission to places of amusement; 5 providing for the licensing of persons reselling such tickets for profit; providing for the suspension and revocation of 7 such licenses; imposing duties on licensees and owners or operators of places of amusement; imposing powers and duties 8 on the Department of Revenue, county treasurers, district 9 10 attorneys, and the receiver of taxes, and city solicitors in 11 cities of the first class; making disposition of moneys collected and providing penalties, "further providing for 12 definitions; and providing for ticket purchasing software AND 13 14 FOR PENALTIES.

15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

16 hereby enacts as follows:

- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings ascribed to them in this section:

- 12 (12) "Ticket purchasing software." Computer software used
- 13 to purchase multiple tickets in an automated fashion from an
- 14 Internet website which sells tickets to amusements or places of
- 15 amusement.
- 16 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 17 <u>Section 12.1. Ticket Purchasing Software; Violation.</u>
- 18 It shall be unlawful for any person to use ticket purchasing

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- 19 software in purchasing tickets from an Internet website selling
- 20 <u>tickets to amusements or places of amusement.</u>
- 21 <u>SECTION 12.1. TICKET PURCHASING SOFTWARE; VIOLATION.--(A)</u>
- 22 IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON KNOWINGLY TO SELL, GIVE, POSSESS,
- 23 USE OR OTHERWISE DISTRIBUTE OR POSSESS WITH THE INTENT TO SELL,
- 24 GIVE OR DISTRIBUTE SOFTWARE THAT IS PRIMARILY DESIGNED OR
- 25 PRODUCED FOR THE PURPOSE OF INTERFERING WITH THE OPERATIONS OF
- 26 ANY TICKET SELLER THAT SELLS, OVER THE INTERNET, TICKETS OF
- 27 ADMISSION TO A SPORTING EVENT, THEATER, MUSICAL PERFORMANCE OR
- 28 PLACE OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT OR AMUSEMENT OF ANY KIND BY
- 29 <u>CIRCUMVENTING ANY SECURITY MEASURES ON THE TICKET SELLER'S</u>
- 30 WEBSITE, CIRCUMVENTING ANY ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEMS OF THE TICKET

- 1 SELLER'S WEBSITE OR CIRCUMVENTING ANY CONTROLS OR MEASURES THAT
- 2 ARE INSTITUTED BY THE TICKET SELLER ON ITS WEBSITE TO ENSURE AN
- 3 EQUITABLE TICKET BUYING PROCESS.
- 4 (B) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "TICKET SELLER" MEANS ANY
- 5 PERSON THAT HAS EXECUTED A WRITTEN AGREEMENT WITH THE MANAGEMENT
- 6 OF ANY VENUE FOR A SPORTING EVENT, THEATER, MUSICAL PERFORMANCE
- 7 OR PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT OR AMUSEMENT OF ANY KIND TO SELL TICKETS
- 8 TO SUCH EVENT OVER THE INTERNET.
- 9 (C) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION COMMITS A
- 10 MISDEMEANOR OF THE THIRD DEGREE. EVERY ACQUISITION, SALE OR
- 11 OFFER FOR SALE CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE VIOLATION.
- 12 (D) THE COURT, IN IMPOSING A SENTENCE, SHALL ORDER
- 13 RESTITUTION PURSUANT TO 18 PA.C.S. § 1106 (RELATING TO
- 14 RESTITUTION FOR INJURIES TO PERSON OR PROPERTY).
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
