AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting mutilation of female genitalia.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 3131. Female mutilation.
- 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits female mutilation
- 10 when:
- 11 (1) the person knowingly circumcises, excises or
- infibulates the whole or any part of the genitalia of a
- 13 <u>female; or</u>
- 14 (2) the person is a parent, quardian or other person who

- is legally responsible for and charged with the care or
- 2 <u>custody of a female child 17 years of age or younger, and who</u>
- 3 <u>allows the circumcision, excision or infibulation of the</u>
- 4 whole or any part of the female child's genitalia.
- 5 (b) Grading.--Female mutilation is a misdemeanor of the
- 6 <u>first degree</u>.
- 7 (c) Exception. -- A surgical operation is not a violation of
- 8 this section if such operation is:
- 9 (1) necessary to the health of the person on whom it is
- 10 performed and either is performed by a licensed physician or
- is performed in the presence of a licensed physician by a
- 12 person in training to become a licensed physician; or
- (2) performed on a person in labor or who has just given
- 14 birth and is performed for medical reasons connected with
- that labor or birth by a licensed physician, by a licensed
- 16 <u>midwife or in the presence of a licensed physician by a</u>
- 17 person in training to become a licensed physician.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
