AN ACT

Amending the act of May 11, 1972 (P.L.286, No.70), entitled "An 2 act regulating the sale of certain structures made, 3 fabricated, formed or assembled in manufacturing facilities 4 and providing penalties, "further providing for definitions and for promulgation of rules and regulations by the 5 6 department. REGULATIONS, INSIGNIA OF CERTIFICATION REQUIRED. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 3(2) of the act of May 11, 1972 (P.L.286, 10 No.70), known as the Industrialized Housing Act, is amended and 11 the section is amended by adding a paragraph to read: Section 3. Definitions. -- As used in this act: 12 13 14 "Department" means the Department of Community [Affairs] 15 and Economic Development of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. * * * 16 (4.1) "Industrialized/commercial modular building" means a 17

structure designed for commercial occupancy, and classified

within nonresidential use groups in accordance with the

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- 1 standards adopted under 12 Pa. Code § 145.41 (relating to
- 2 <u>adoption of standards</u>) and which is wholly or in substantial
- 3 part made, constructed, fabricated, formed or assembled in
- 4 manufacturing facilities for installation or assembly and
- 5 installation on the building site so that concealed parts or
- 6 processes of manufacture cannot be inspected at the site without
- 7 disassembly, damage or destruction. The term does not include
- 8 <u>industrialized housing as defined in 12 Pa. Code § 145.1</u>
- 9 (relating to definitions) or manufactured home, as defined in
- 10 section 5402(6) of the National Manufactured Housing
- 11 Construction and Safety Standards Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383
- 12 <u>42 U.S.C. § 5401 et seq.).</u>

- 14 Section 2. Section 5 of the act is amended by adding a

- 16 Section 5. Promulgation of Rules and Regulations by the
- 17 Department. * * *
- 18 (c) The department shall promulgate regulations for
- 19 industrialized/commercial modular buildings and is authorized to
- 20 <u>enter into a multi state agreement for the purpose of regulating</u>
- 21 <u>the buildings.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. SECTION 4 OF THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A
- 23 SUBSECTION TO READ:
- 24 SECTION 4. REGULATIONS, INSIGNIA OF CERTIFICATION
- 25 REQUIRED. --* * *
- 26 (J) THE DEPARTMENT IS AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO A MULTISTATE
- 27 AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF
- 28 COMPONENTS OF INDUSTRIALIZED/COMMERCIAL MODULAR BUILDINGS. THE
- 29 <u>DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM</u>
- 30 THAT ARE BASED ON THE MODEL RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY

- 1 THE INTERSTATE INDUSTRIALIZED BUILDINGS COMMISSION. COMPONENTS
- 2 OF INDUSTRIALIZED/COMMERCIAL MODULAR BUILDINGS THAT ARE
- 3 CERTIFIED UNDER THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS
- 4 SUBSECTION SHALL BE DEEMED TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ACT
- 5 OF NOVEMBER 10, 1999 (P.L.491, NO.45), KNOWN AS THE
- 6 "PENNSYLVANIA CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT."
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008, or
- 8 immediately, whichever is later.
