## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act to empower cities of the second class A, 3 and third class, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships of 4 the first and second classes including those within a county 5 of the second class and counties of the second through eighth 6 classes, individually or jointly, to plan their development 7 and to govern the same by zoning, subdivision and land 8 development ordinances, planned residential development and other ordinances, by official maps, by the reservation of 9 10 certain land for future public purpose and by the acquisition 11 of such land; to promote the conservation of energy through 12 the use of planning practices and to promote the effective 13 utilization of renewable energy sources; providing for the 14 establishment of planning commissions, planning departments, 15 planning committees and zoning hearing boards, authorizing 16 them to charge fees, make inspections and hold public 17 hearings; providing for mediation; providing for transferable development rights; providing for appropriations, appeals to 18 19 courts and penalties for violations; and repealing acts and 20 <del>parts of acts," prohibiting the operation of syringe exchange</del> 21 programs in certain locations. 22 LIMITING THE OPERATION OF SYRINGE-EXCHANGE PROGRAMS IN CITIES OF 23 THE FIRST CLASS. 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 25 hereby enacts as follows: 26 Section 1. The act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), known

as the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, reenacted and

- 1 amended December 21, 1988 (P.L.1329, No.170), is amended by
- 2 adding a section to read:
- 3 <u>Section 622. Prohibiting the Operation of Syringe exchange</u>
- 4 Programs in Certain Locations. (a) (1) Notwithstanding any
- 5 other provision of law to the contrary, a syringe exchange
- 6 program shall not be operated within 500 feet of a residential
- 7 housing development in a city of the first class.
- 8 (2) The provisions of this subsection shall apply whether or
- 9 not a permit has been issued to the operator of the syringe
- 10 exchange program for a location that is within 500 feet of a
- 11 residential housing development in a city of the first class.
- 12 (b) As used in this section, the term "syringe exchange
- 13 program" shall mean a program which exchanges unused syringes
- 14 for used syringes and is conducted pursuant to an executive
- 15 order by a mayor in a city of the first class.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 17 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 18 THIS ACT SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE SYRINGE-

- 19 EXCHANGE PROGRAM LIMITATION ACT.
- 20 SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.
- THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS ACT SHALL
- 22 HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE
- 23 CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 24 "CITY." A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS.
- 25 "SYRINGE-EXCHANGE PROGRAM." A PROGRAM WHICH EXCHANGES UNUSED
- 26 SYRINGES FOR USED SYRINGES AND IS CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO AN
- 27 EXECUTIVE ORDER BY A MAYOR OF A CITY OF THE FIRST CLASS.
- 28 SECTION 3. LIMITATION.
- 29 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF STATUTE, CHARTER,
- 30 ORDINANCE OR OTHER LAW TO THE CONTRARY, A SYRINGE-EXCHANGE

- 1 PROGRAM MAY NOT OPERATE WITHIN 500 FEET OF A RESIDENTIAL HOUSING
- 2 DEVELOPMENT IN A CITY.
- 3 SECTION 4. APPLICABILITY.
- THIS ACT SHALL APPLY REGARDLESS OF WHETHER A PERMIT HAS BEEN 4
- 5 ISSUED TO THE OPERATOR OF A SYRINGE-EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR A
- 6 LOCATION THAT IS WITHIN 500 FEET OF A RESIDENTIAL HOUSING
- 7 DEVELOPMENT IN A CITY.
- 8 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 9 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
