AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for restriction on participation in extracurricular activities.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
as the Public School Code of 1949 , is amended by adding a
section to read:
Section 1317.4. Restriction on Participation in
Extracurricular Activities.--(a) A school district shall
suspend a student from participation in an extracurricular
activity if the student is convicted or adjudicated delinquent of any offense under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act." The length of the suspension shall be established by school policy.
(b) As used in this section, the term "extracurricular activity" means:
(1) An activity covered by the provisions of section 511 which meets the following criteria:
(i) The activity is sponsored or approved by the board of school directors.
(ii) The activity is not offered for credit toward graduation.
(iii) The activity is conducted partially or entirely outside the regular instructional day schedule.
(iv) The activity is available to any student enrolled in a school within the school district who voluntarily elects to participate and be subject to the eligibility requirements of the activity.
(2) A school district's program of interscholastic athletics, including varsity sports, shall be deemed extracurricular in nature and shall include all activities relating to competitive sports contests, games, events or exhibitions involving individual students or teams of students of the school district whenever the activities occur between schools within a district or with schools outside the district. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
