AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An 2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing 5 for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 9 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and penalties," further providing for exclusions from sales and 10 11 use tax.
- 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 13 hereby enacts as follows:
- 14 Section 1. Section 204 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6,
- 15 No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by
- 16 adding a clause to read:
- 17 Section 204. Exclusions from Tax. -- The tax imposed by
- 18 section 202 shall not be imposed upon any of the following:

- (67) The sale at retail or use of used books at local and 1
- 2 <u>county libraries.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
