AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Emergency Home Heating Fund; allocating funds;
- 2 and imposing powers and duties on the Department of Public
- 3 Welfare.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Emergency
- 8 Home Heating Fund Assistance Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Department." The Department of Public Welfare of the
- 14 Commonwealth.
- 15 "Fund." The Emergency Home Heating Fund established in
- 16 section 3.
- 17 "LIHEAP." The program established by Title XXVI of the

- 1 Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981 (Public Law 97-35, 42
- 2 U.S.C. § 8621 et seq.).
- 3 Section 3. Fund.
- 4 (a) Establishment. -- The Emergency Home Heating Fund is
- 5 established as a separate fund in the State Treasury.
- 6 (b) Purpose.--The purpose of the fund is to supplement
- 7 LIHEAP.
- 8 (c) Sources.--The following are the sources of the fund:
- 9 (1) A transfer of \$2,500 from each Caucus Operations
- 10 Account under section 251 of the act of July 4, 2008 (P.L.
- 11 , No.38A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2008.
- 12 (2) A transfer of \$2,500 from each Special Leadership
- 13 Account in section 252 of the General Appropriation Act of
- 14 2008.
- 15 (3) Appropriations.
- 16 (4) Return on the money in the fund.
- 17 (d) Use.--The department shall use the fund for State-funded
- 18 emergency home heating assistance when the Governor issues a
- 19 declaration that weather conditions, natural or manmade
- 20 disasters or high energy prices or any combination of those
- 21 factors are a threat to public health within this Commonwealth
- 22 and available LIHEAP funds are not sufficient to meet this need.
- 23 The department shall use the fund in accordance with the crisis
- 24 grant portion of LIHEAP.
- 25 (e) Nonlapse. -- The money in the fund is continuously
- 26 appropriated into the fund. This appropriation shall not lapse
- 27 at the end of any fiscal year.
- 28 Section 20. Effective date.
- 29 This act shall take effect immediately.
