## A RESOLUTION

Designating the month of April 2007 as "Hemophilia Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, Hemophilia is a genetic disorder that impairs the body's ability to control bleeding; and WHEREAS, Hemophilia is defined as excessive, uncontrollable bleeding because of a missing or low-level clotting factor in the blood; and

WHEREAS, Bleeding may occur even when there is no injury and most often occurs in the joints and in the head; and WHEREAS, There are approximately 20,000 United States citizens with hemophilia, and each year approximately 400 babies are born with the disorder; and

WHEREAS, There are approximately 1,700 citizens of this

Commonwealth living with hemophilia; and
WHEREAS, Hemophilia affects males almost exclusively and is found in all populations; and

WHEREAS, There is no cure for hemophilia, a lifelong condition that must be controlled with intravenous infusion of factor replacement therapies; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the Pennsylvania.
