A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the Alliance of Bikers Aimed Toward Education of

5 WHEREAS, The Readshaw Raiders Ride to Gettysburg is an annual

7 Civil War Monuments Preservation Project; and

9 more than \$40,000 in donations over the past five years; and

11 leadership, ABATE celebrates the 30th anniversary of its
