1 Commemorating the sixth anniversary of the Educational
2 Improvement Tax Credit on May 8, 2007.

3 WHEREAS, The Educational Improvement Tax Credit was
4 implemented on May 6, 2001; and

5 WHEREAS, The Educational Improvement Tax Credit has provided
6 educational help for tens of thousands of Pennsylvania students
7 during the past six years; and

8 WHEREAS, For the current school year, more than 33,000
9 students benefited from Educational Improvement Tax Credit
10 scholarships; and

11 WHEREAS, More than \$240 million has been contributed to
12 eligible Educational Improvement Tax Credit organizations by
13 more than 2,200 businesses since the program began in 2001;
14 therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate the

1 sixth anniversary of the Educational Improvement Tax Credit on
2 May 8, 2007.
