## A RESOLUTION

Observing August 1, 2007, as "World Scouting Day" in Pennsylvania in commemoration of the lo0th anniversary of the establishment of the Scout Movement.

WHEREAS, On August 1, 1907, Lord Robert Baden-Powell first
organized a small camp on Brownsea Island, England, to train
young boys on the skills of life and the outdoors; and
WHEREAS, The Brownsea Island camp, which lasted for nine days, sought to put Lord Baden-Powell's book titled "Scouting for Boys" into practice; and

WHEREAS, The success of "Scouting for Boys" and the Brownsea

Island camp produced a movement that reached a worldwide membership of more than 1 million youths by 1922; and WHEREAS, Today there are more than 28 million Scouts worldwide in 216 countries and territories; and

WHEREAS, More than 300 million people have participated in Scouting since Lord Baden-Powell's first camp; and

WHEREAS, One well-known group in the United States, which was established as a result of Lord Baden-Powell's scouting movement, became known as the Boy Scouts of America; and WHEREAS, The Boy Scouts of America in 2007 includes more than 3.4 million Boy Scouts, representing 142,587 scouting units and 321 councils in 16,800 communities across 50 states; and WHEREAS, Lord Baden-Powell's idea and determination to organize, educate and train young boys was destined to become and continues to be the world's largest voluntary youth movement encompassing Scouts across the entire globe; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives observe August 1, 2007, as "World Scouting Day" in Pennsylvania in commemoration of the $100 t h$ anniversary of the establishment of the Scout Movement and in appreciation of the vision and work of Lord Baden-Powell.
