A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of June 2007 as "Corrections Officers and
2 Employees Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees form the backbone
4 of our State correctional system; and

5 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees place themselves
6 in danger every day as they patrol the toughest precincts in
7 this Commonwealth; and

8 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees are charged with
9 the care, custody and control of our State prisoner population
10 and, as such, are the first element in the rehabilitation of
11 incarcerated persons; and

12 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees are actively

1 involved in their communities through volunteer service and
2 civic participation; and

3 WHEREAS, Corrections officers and employees continue to work
4 effectively with State prison officials to create well-run
5 correctional facilities, foster teamwork and support an
6 effective detention system; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
8 month of June 2007 as "Corrections Officers and Employees Month"
9 in Pennsylvania in recognition of the valuable contributions of
10 these fine professionals.
