## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing October 11, 2007, as "National Depression Screening Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, National Depression Screening Day, held each year
- 4 during Mental Illness Awareness Week, is designed to call
- 5 attention to the illness of depression on a national level, to
- 6 educate the public about its symptoms and effective treatments
- 7 and to connect those in need of treatment to the mental health
- 8 care systems; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 1991 only 90 screening sites were available, and
- 10 the number climbed to 3,000 in 1998; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Each year over 100,000 persons are screened for
- 12 depression, and the resulting data has provided valuable help
- 13 for those in need; therefore be it

- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize October 1
- 11, 2007, as "National Depression Screening Day" in
- 3 Pennsylvania.
