L2	families in need by providing block grants of Federal funds to
L3	states and wide flexibility to develop and implement their own
L 4	welfare programs; and
L 5	WHEREAS, The main purposes of TANF are to assist needy
L6	families so that their children can be cared for in their own
L7	homes, to reduce the dependency of parents who are in need by
L8	promoting job preparation, work and marriage, to prevent out-of-
L9	wedlock pregnancies and to encourage the formation and

- 2 WHEREAS, In order to receive assistance and benefits through
- 3 TANF, parents who are in need must comply with certain work
- 4 requirements; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Recipients of TANF can better retain jobs for the
- 6 long term if they are high school graduates or have a general
- 7 equivalency diploma, commonly known as a GED; and
- 8 WHEREAS, TANF does not require recipients to have a high
- 9 school diploma or GED; therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
- 12 States to amend the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity
- 13 Reconciliation Act of 1996 to require INCLUDE OBTAINING a high
