A RESOLUTION

- Designating April 8, 2008, as "Cushing's Syndrome Awareness Day"
 in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Cushing's syndrome is a disorder of the endocrine
- 4 system in which excessive levels of cortisol are produced; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Often misdiagnosed, Cushing's is a relatively rare
- 6 disorder affecting approximately 10 to 15 out of every million
- 7 people and affecting five times as many women as men; and
- 8 WHEREAS, April 8th is the birthday anniversary of
- 9 neurosurgeon Dr. Harvey Cushing, who discovered the illness;
- 10 therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April
- 12 8, 2008, as "Cushing's Syndrome Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
