## AN ACT

Protecting the right of a mother to nurse her child in public; 1 2 prohibiting a unit of local government from adopting an 3 ordinance prohibiting breastfeeding in public; and providing that breastfeeding may not be considered a nuisance, indecent 5 exposure, sexual conduct or obscenity. WHEREAS, There are benefits to the child, the mother and 6 7 society by encouraging and enabling mothers to breastfeed their children; and 8 9 WHEREAS, An infant who is breastfed receives protection against infection, illness and allergies, and long-term positive 10 11 effects on the development, intelligence and health of breastfed 12 children have been found; and 13 WHEREAS, A protective effect against various types of cancer 14 and greater emotional and physical health are found for mothers who breastfeed; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Breastfeeding promotes sufficient birth spacing, 17 improved vaccine effectiveness and decreased food and medical expenses, which all have positive societal effects; and 18

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Supplemental Food Program for

- 1 Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) promotes breastfeeding
- 2 education and support; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Legislation to clarify the right to breastfeed is
- 4 necessary to promote breastfeeding and remove any stumbling
- 5 block from influencing a mother's decision to breastfeed or
- 6 continue breastfeeding.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 10 Right to Breastfeed Act.
- 11 Section 2. Declaration of policy.
- 12 The General Assembly finds that breastfeeding a baby is an
- 13 important and basic act of nurturing that must be protected in
- 14 the interests of maternal and child health and family values.
- 15 Section 3. General rule.
- 16 A mother has a right to breastfeed her child in any location,
- 17 public or private, where the mother and child are otherwise
- 18 authorized to be present, irrespective of whether or not the
- 19 mother's breast is covered during or incidental to the
- 20 breastfeeding.
- 21 Section 4. Local ordinance prohibition.
- 22 A unit of local government may not prohibit breastfeeding in
- 23 public by local ordinance.
- 24 Section 5. Right to breastfeed.
- 25 The act of breastfeeding may not be considered:
- 26 (1) Indecent exposure as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3127
- 27 (relating to indecent exposure).
- 28 (2) Obscenity or sexual conduct as defined in 18 Pa.C.S.
- 29 § 5903 (relating to obscene and other sexual materials and
- 30 performances).

- (3) A nuisance as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6504 (relating 1
- to public nuisances). 2
- 3 Section 10. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
