AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.566, No.284), entitled  
2 "An act defining the liability of an employer to pay damages  
3 for occupational disease contracted by an employe arising out  
4 of and in the course of employment; establishing an elective  
5 schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the  
6 determination of liability and compensation thereunder;  
7 imposing duties on the Department of Labor and Industry, the  
8 Workmen's Compensation Board, Workmen's Compensation  
9 Referees, and deans of medical schools; creating a medical  
10 board to determine controverted medical issues; establishing  
11 an Occupational Disease Fund in custody of the State  
12 Workmen's Insurance Board; imposing upon the Commonwealth a  
13 part of the compensation payable for certain occupational  
14 diseases; making an appropriation; and prescribing  
15 penalties," providing further benefits.

16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
17 hereby enacts as follows:

18 Section 1. Section 301 of the act of June 21, 1939 (P.L.566,  
19 No.284), known as The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act, is  
20 amended by adding a subsection to read:

21 Section 301. \* \* \*

22 (m) Every person heretofore or hereafter qualified for

1 additional compensation under the provisions of clause (2) of  
2 subsection (a) or subsection (i) shall, beginning with the month  
3 following the effective date of this subsection, or the month of  
4 qualification, whichever occurs later, be paid further  
5 compensation of ~~twenty five dollars (\$25)~~ FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50) <—  
6 per month during the period of disability. Such further  
7 compensation paid to a person heretofore or hereafter qualified  
8 shall be paid by the Commonwealth.

9       Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007, ~~or~~ <—  
10 ~~immediately, whichever is later~~ 2009. <—
