AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the offense of failure
- 3 to provide identification to law enforcement authorities.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 4914.1. Failure to provide identification to law enforcement
- 9 <u>authorities.</u>
- 10 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits an offense if he
- 11 fails to provide law enforcement authorities with identification
- 12 or information about his identity after being stopped based upon
- 13 reasonable suspicion that the person has committed, is
- 14 committing or is about to commit a crime and informed by a law
- 15 enforcement officer who is in uniform or who has identified
- 16 himself as a law enforcement officer that the person is the
- 17 subject of an official investigation of a violation of law.
- 18 (b) Grading.--An offense under this section is a misdemeanor

- 1 of the third degree.
- 2 (c) Detention. -- A person may be detained by law enforcement
- 3 <u>authorities in a reasonable manner and for a reasonable time to</u>
- 4 require the person to identify himself. However, the person
- 5 shall not be compelled to answer any other question of any law
- 6 <u>enforcement officer</u>.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
