AN ACT

1 Amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), entitled
2 "An act establishing a uniform construction code; imposing
3 powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of
4 Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; imposing
5 penalties; and making repeals," further providing for
6 application, FOR CHANGES IN THE UNIFORM CONSTRUCTION CODE and ←
7 for exemptions.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 104(b)(7) of the act of November 10, 1999
11 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code
12 Act, amended July 15, 2004 (P.L.748, No.92), is amended and the
13 subsection is amended by adding a ~~paragraph~~ PARAGRAPHS A ←
14 PARAGRAPH to read:

15 Section 104. Application.

17 (b) Exclusions.--This act shall not apply to:

1 (7) any recreational cabin if:

2 (i) the cabin is equipped with at least one smoke
3 detector, one fire extinguisher and one carbon monoxide
4 detector in both the kitchen and sleeping quarters; [and]

5 (ii) the owner of the cabin files with the
6 municipality either:

7 (A) an affidavit on a form prescribed by the
8 department attesting to the fact that the cabin meets
9 the definition of a "recreational cabin" in section
10 103; or

11 (B) a valid proof of insurance for the
12 recreational cabin, written and issued by an insurer
13 authorized to do business in this Commonwealth,
14 stating that the structure meets the definition of a
15 "recreational cabin" as defined in section 103[.];

7 Section 2. Section 901 of the act is amended by adding a
8 subsection to read:

9 Section 901. Exemptions.

11 (e) Pole barns at agricultural fairs.--Neither this act nor
12 any adoption of the International Fire Code by a Commonwealth
13 agency, a political subdivision or a local agency shall apply to
14 a pole barn that is constructed on agricultural fairgrounds and
15 is only used for agricultural purposes and animal display. This
16 section shall not apply to inspections required pursuant to the
17 ICC Electrical Code or its successor codes.

18 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
