## AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the use of mobile telephones.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
6	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
7	§ 3316. Prohibiting the use of mobile telephones.
8	(a) ProhibitionExcept as otherwise provided in this
9	section, no person shall operate a motor vehicle upon a public
10	highway while using a mobile telephone to engage in a call while
11	such vehicle is in motion.
12	(b) PresumptionAn operator of a motor vehicle who holds a
13	mobile telephone to, or in the immediate proximity of his or her
14	ear while such vehicle is in motion is presumed to be engaging
15	in a call within the meaning of this section. The presumption
16	established by this subsection is rebuttable by evidence tending
17	to show that the operator was not engaged in a call.

1	(c) SeizureThe provisions of this section shall not be
2	construed as authorizing the seizure or forfeiture of a mobile
3	telephone, unless otherwise provided by law.
4	(d) ApplicabilityThis section shall not apply to:
5	(1) the use of a mobile telephone for the sole purpose
б	of communicating with any of the following regarding an
7	emergency situation: an emergency response operator; a
8	hospital, physician's office or health clinic; an ambulance
9	company or corps; a fire department, district or company; or
10	<u>a police department;</u>
11	(2) any of the following persons while in the
12	performance of their official duties: a police officer or
13	peace officer; a member of a fire department, district or
14	company; or
15	(3) the use of a hands-free mobile telephone.
16	(e) PenaltyA violation of subsection (a) shall be a
17	traffic infraction and shall be punishable by a fine of not more
18	<u>than \$100.</u>
19	(f) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
20	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
21	subsection:
22	"Engage in a call." Talking into or listening on a hand-held
23	mobile telephone, but shall not include holding a mobile
24	telephone to activate, deactivate or initiate a function of such
25	telephone.
26	"Hand-held mobile telephone." A mobile telephone with which
27	a user engages in a call using at least one hand.
28	"Hands-free mobile telephone." A mobile telephone that has
29	an internal feature or function, or that is equipped with an
30	attachment or addition, whether or not permanently part of such

1	mobile telephone, by which a user engages in a call without the
2	use of either hand whether or not the use of either hand is
3	necessary to activate, deactivate or initiate a function of such
4	telephone.
5	"Immediate proximity." That distance as permits the operator
6	of a mobile telephone to hear telecommunications transmitted
7	over such mobile telephone, but shall not require physical
8	contact with such operator's ear.
9	"Mobile telephone." The device used by subscribers and other
10	users of wireless telephone service to access such service.
11	<u>"Using." Holding a mobile telephone to, or in the immediate</u>
12	proximity of, the user's ear.
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
