## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), entitled "An act creating the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources consisting of certain functions of the Department of Environmental Resources and the Department of Community Affairs; renaming the Department of Environmental Resources as the Department of Environmental Protection; defining the role of the Environmental Quality Board in the Department of Environmental Protection; making changes to responsibilities of the State Conservation Commission and the Department of Agriculture; transferring certain powers and duties to the Department of Health; and repealing inconsistent acts," further providing for rivers conservation; and establishing the Water Recreation Advisory Board.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 307 heading of the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), known as the Conservation and Natural Resources Act, is amended and the section is amended by adding a
subsection to read:
Section 307. [Rivers conservation] Water resources and
recreation.

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(c) Inventory of recreational opportunities.--
(1) The department shall inventory all rivers, streams and lakes in this Commonwealth to identify current boating, canoeing, rafting and other recreational activities, including water levels and related water conditions, for the purpose of making the information available to the public in published form.
(2) The inventory shall include, but not be limited to, recreational activities offered by: (i) the department; (ii) the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission; (iii) the Pennsylvania Game Commission; (iv) the National Park Service; (v) the United States Army Corps of Engineers; (vi) the United States Soil Conservation Service; (vii) the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission; (viii) the United States Forest Service; and (ix) other public and private entities.
(3) The Water Recreation Advisory Board shall assist the department in compiling the inventory. The first inventory shall be completed by January 1, 2009, and shall be updated every two years.

Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: Section 315.1. Water Recreation Advisory Board. (a) Establishment.--There is hereby established the Water Recreation Advisory Board to assist the department in identifying water resources for recreational activities and in compiling the inventory required by section 307 (c).
(b) Members.--The board shall be composed of representatives of environmental and recreational organizations, especially interested in water resources and water recreational activities.

The members of the board shall be appointed by the secretary and shall represent the various geographical regions of this Commonwealth. The secretary shall designate a member of the board as presiding officer. The board shall meet at least annually.
(c) Expenses of members.--The members of the board shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in carrying out their duties as members of the board.
(d) Other duties.--In addition to assisting the department in identifying water resources for recreational activities and in compiling the inventory required by section 307 (c), the board shall have such other duties as may be determined by the secretary.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
