12	Section 1. Section 6(c) of the act of January 24, 1966 (1965
13	P.L.1527, No.535), known as the Landscape Architects'

18	(c) The board may register and license without written
19	examination [(i)] a person who holds an unexpired license or

qualifications to engage in the practice of landscape 1 architecture were at the time of initial issuance of a license 2 3 or certificate of registration at least equal to the standards 4 of this Commonwealth existing at that time.[; or (ii) an 5 applicant who has ten years of active experience as a landscape architect and is a graduate of an approved institution, or who 6 has fifteen years of active experience even though not a 7 8 graduate of an approved institution, if in the opinion of the board the experience is of such grade and character as to fit 9 10 the person to assume responsible charge of work involved in the 11 practice of landscape architecture.]

Section 2. Section 9.1(b) of the act, added December 7, 1994 (P.L.774, No.107), is amended to read:

14 Section 9.1. Continuing Education Required.--* * *

(b) Beginning with the license period designated by [regulation] <u>the board</u>, each person licensed under this act shall be required to obtain [ten] <u>twenty-four</u> hours of mandatory continuing education during each two-year license period. A licensed landscape architect who wishes to activate a license which has been placed on inactive status shall be required to document [ten] <u>twenty-four</u> hours of continuing education.
