or a pilot offers his services, outside of a 1 straight line drawn from Cape Henlopen Light to 2 3 Cape May Light, and every ship or vessel bound to 4 the breakwater for orders shall pay pilotage fees 5 as follows: A sum equal to half the pilotage to the Port of Philadelphia, and she shall be obliged 6 7 to take a pilot and pay the same pilotage fees when outward bound, from the breakwater, and if 8 such ship or vessel, without discharging her 9 10 pilot, proceed to the Port of Philadelphia or any 11 other port or place on the bay or river Delaware, only one full pilotage fee as fixed by section 3.1 12 13 of this act, for the entire service, in addition to the fee for detention: Provided, however, That 14 15 if the pilot bringing such ship or vessel to the 16 breakwater be there discharged, and the ship or 17 vessel afterward proceed to Philadelphia or any 18 other port or place on the bay or river Delaware, 19 she shall make the usual signal for a pilot and 20 continue to make such signal till reaching 21 Brandywine Light, and if spoken by, or offered the 22 services of, a duly licensed Pennsylvania pilot before reaching Brandywine Light, shall be obliged 23 to employ such pilot and pay him for services 24 rendered on and after the effective date of this 25 26 act, a charge computed as follows: * * * 27 The charges per unit shall be as follows: 28 (b)

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
