AN ACT

- 1 Amending Titles 24 (Education) and 71 (State Government) of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for referendum
- 3 on public pension increases.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 8536. Referenda on benefit increases required.
- 9 (a) Requirement of referendum. -- No increase in benefits,
- 10 other than a supplemental annuity to reflect an increase in cost
- 11 of living, shall be effective until the increase in benefits has
- 12 been approved by the electorate.
- (b) Notification. -- Upon the passage by the General Assembly
- 14 of a proposed increase in benefits, the Secretary of the
- 15 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 16 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 17 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 18 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such

- 1 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of the
- 2 proposed increase in benefits. The Secretary of the Commonwealth
- 3 shall submit the proposed increase in benefits to the qualified
- 4 electors of this Commonwealth at the first primary, general or
- 5 municipal election occurring at least three months after the
- 6 <u>legislation</u> is passed by the General Assembly.

- 12 (d) Nonlegal interpretative statement.--The Department of

- 15 <u>section 201.1 of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320)</u>,
- 16 known as the Pennsylvania Election Code.
- 17 (e) Certification of results.--The Secretary of the

- 19 accordance with the Pennsylvania Election Code.
- 20 (f) Referendum approval.--Approval of the referendum

- 23 Section 2. Title 71 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 24 § 5711. Referenda on benefit increases required.
- 25 (a) Requirement of referendum. -- No increase in benefits,
- 26 other than a supplemental annuity to reflect an increase in cost
- 27 of living, shall be effective until the increase in benefits has
- 28 been approved by the electorate.
- 29 (b) Notification. -- Upon the passage by the General Assembly
