1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to the practice of professional nursing; providing for the licensing of nurses and for the revocation and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for their reinstatement; providing for the renewal of such licenses; regulating nursing in general; prescribing penalties and repealing certain laws," further providing for definitions; and providing for certified registered nurse anesthetist qualifications.
10	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
11	hereby enacts as follows:
12	Section 1. Section 2(1) of the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317,
13	No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, amended December
14	9, 2002 (P.L.1567, No.206), is amended and the section is
15	amended by adding a clause to read:
16	Section 2. DefinitionsWhen used in this act, the
17	following words and phrases shall have the following meanings
18	unless the context provides otherwise:
19	(1) The "Practice of Professional Nursing" means diagnosing
20	and treating human responses to actual or potential health
21	problems through such services as casefinding, health teaching,

health counseling, and provision of care supportive to or 1 restorative of life and well-being, and executing medical 2 3 regimens as prescribed by a licensed physician or dentist. The 4 foregoing shall not be deemed to include acts of medical 5 diagnosis or prescription of medical therapeutic or corrective measures, except as performed by a certified registered nurse 6 practitioner acting in accordance with rules and regulations 7 8 promulgated by the Board. Other than the administration of 9 conscious sedation, the foregoing shall be deemed to include the administration of anesthesia only if performed by a certified 10 11 registered nurse anesthetist. * * * 12 13 (15) "Certified registered nurse anesthetist" means a registered nurse licensed in this Commonwealth and certified by 14 the Board, pursuant to section 3.2, to administer anesthesia. 15 16 Section 2. The act is amended by adding sections to read: 17 Section 3.2. Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists; 18 Qualifications.--(a) The Board shall certify a licensed registered nurse as a certified registered nurse anesthetist if 19 20 the nurse satisfies the requirements established by this act and 21 regulations promulgated by the Board. 22 (b) Certification of a nurse under this section shall expire 23 on the same date as the license of that nurse expires. 24 (c) A licensed registered nurse shall not qualify for 25 certification by the Board under this section unless the nurse: 26 (1) has successfully completed the educational program of a school for nurse anesthetists accredited by an accrediting 27 28 agency recognized by the Board; and 29 (2) holds certification as a certified registered nurse anesthetist by a Board-recognized national certification 30 20070S0891B1042 - 2 -

1 <u>organization</u>.

2	(d) A licensed registered nurse who is enrolled in an
3	educational program of a school for nurse anesthetists
4	accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Board may,
5	during such enrollment, administer anesthesia under the
6	<u>direction of the chief or director of anesthesia services, a</u>
7	Board-certified anesthesiologist or a certified registered nurse
8	anesthetist.
9	(e) (1) A licensed registered nurse who has obtained the
10	education required by subsection (c), but who has not yet
11	obtained certification as a registered nurse anesthetist, may
12	administer anesthesia under the direction of the chief or
13	director of anesthesia services, a Board-certified
14	anesthesiologist or a certified registered nurse anesthetist
15	until the announcement of results of the first examination taken
16	for certification for which the registered nurse is eligible.
17	(2) If the registered nurse fails to take, or fails to pass,
18	that examination, the nurse shall immediately cease practicing
19	as a nurse anesthetist, Provided, however, That the registered
20	nurse may appeal to the Board for authority to continue
21	practicing as a nurse anesthetist if, due to extenuating
22	circumstances, the nurse is unable to take the examination in a
23	time period specified by the Board following attainment of the
24	required education.
25	Section 3.3. Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists; Scope
26	of Practice(a) (1) A certified registered nurse anesthetist
27	shall administer anesthesia in cooperation with a physician,
28	<u>dentist or podiatrist.</u>
29	(2) For purposes of this section, "cooperation" shall mean a
30	process in which the certified registered nurse anesthetist and
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1	the physician, dentist or podiatrist work together with each
2	contributing an area of expertise at the individual and
3	respective level of education and training of the certified
4	registered nurse anesthetist and the physician, dentist or
5	podiatrist.
6	(b) A certified registered nurse anesthetist's performance
7	shall be under the overall direction of the chief or director of
8	anesthesia services: Provided, however, That in situations or
9	health care delivery facilities where anesthesia services are
10	not mandatory, the certified registered nurse anesthetist's
11	performance shall be under the overall direction of the
12	physician, dentist or podiatrist responsible for the patient's
13	care.
14	(c) When the operating/anesthesia team consists entirely of
15	nonphysicians, an anesthesiologist or consulting physician of
16	the certified registered nurse anesthetist's choice shall be
17	available to the certified registered nurse anesthetist by
18	physical presence or electronic communication.
19	Section 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
20	prohibit the continued practice of certified registered nurse
21	anesthetists who were authorized to practice in this
22	Commonwealth on the effective date of this section.
23	Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
