## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of stalking.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2709.1(c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 2709.1. Stalking.
(c) Grading.--
(1) Except as otherwise provided for in [paragraph (2), a first] this subsection, an offense under this section shall constitute a misdemeanor of the first degree.
(2) A second or subsequent offense under this section or a first offense under [subsection (a)] this section if the person has been previously convicted of a crime of violence involving the same victim, family or household member, including, but not limited to, a violation of section 2701
(relating to simple assault), 2702 (relating to aggravated
assault), 2705 (relating to recklessly endangering another
person), 2901 (relating to kidnapping), 3121 (relating to
rape) or 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual
intercourse), an order issued under section 4954 (relating to
protective orders) or an order issued under 23 Pa.C.S. § 6108
(relating to relief) or if the person is convicted of
committing any other misdemeanor during the course of this
offense shall constitute a felony of the third degree.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
