8	Section 1. Short title.	<
9	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Mental Health	
10	Services Reimbursement Act.	
11	Section 2. Definitions.	
12	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall	
13	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the	
14	context clearly indicates otherwise:	
15	"Health insurance policy." Any individual or group health	
16	insurance policy, subscriber contract, certificate or plan which	
17	provides medical or health care coverage which is offered by or	
18	is governed under any of the following:	

1	(1) Any stock insurance company incorporated for the			
2	purposes set forth in section 202(c) of the act of May 17,			
3	1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of			
4	<del>1921.</del>			
5	(2) Any mutual insurance company incorporated for any of			
6	the purposes set forth in section 202(d) of The Insurance			
7	Company Law of 1921.			
8	(3) Any professional health services plan corporation as			
9	defined in 40 Pa.C.S. Ch. 63 (relating to professional health			
10	services plan corporations).			
11	(4) Any fraternal benefit society as defined in 40			
12	<del>Pa.C.S. Ch. 63.</del>			
13	(5) Any health maintenance organization as defined in			
14	the act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364), known as the			
15	Health Maintenance Organization Act.			
16	(6) Any person who sells or issues contracts or			
17	certificates of insurance which meet the requirements of this			
18	<del>act.</del>			
19	(7) Any hospital plan corporation as defined in 40			
20	Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to hospital plan corporations).			
21	"Licensed clinical social worker." A provider with a			
22	master's or doctoral degree in social work who assesses,			
23	intervenes and treats individuals, families and groups with			
24	biopsychosocial problems or disorders and who holds a current			
25	advanced standing clinical license under the act of July 9, 1987			
26	(P.L.220, No.39), known as the Social Workers, Marriage and			
27	Family Therapists and Professional Counselors Act.			
28	Section 3. Reimbursement for services provided by licensed			
29	clinical social workers.			
30	(a) Reimbursement. Whenever a health insurance policy			
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provides reimbursement for any mental health service which is
within those areas of practice for which a licensed clinical
social worker is licensed to provide, the insured or any other
person covered by the policy shall be entitled to reimbursement
for such service duly provided.

6 (b) Licensed clinical social worker rights. Whenever such service is performed by a licensed clinical social worker and 7 reimbursed by a professional health services plan corporation, 8 the licensed clinical social worker shall be granted such rights 9 10 of participation, plan admission and registration as may be 11 granted by the professional health services plan corporation under 40 Pa.C.S. Ch. 63 (relating to professional health 12 13 services plan corporations). 14 Section 4. Rules and regulations. 15 The Insurance Commissioner may promulgate such rules and 16 regulations as are deemed necessary for the effective 17 implementation and operation of this act. 18 Section 5. 24 § 6302. DEFINITIONS.

(A) GENERAL RULE.--THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED
IN THIS CHAPTER SHALL HAVE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES
OTHERWISE, THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION:

 30 <u>SERVICES RENDERED AND CARE ADMINISTERED BY LICENSED CLINICAL</u>

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<u>SOCIAL WORKERS AS DEFINED AS THE "PRACTICE OF CLINICAL SOCIAL</u>
 <u>WORK" IN THE ACT OF JULY 9, 1987 (P.L.220, NO.39), KNOWN AS THE</u>
 <u>SOCIAL WORKERS, MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS AND PROFESSIONAL</u>
 <u>COUNSELORS ACT.</u>

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6 "HEALTH SERVICE DOCTOR." A DOCTOR OF DENTAL SURGERY, DOCTOR
7 OF MEDICINE, DOCTOR OF OPTOMETRY, DOCTOR OF OSTEOPATHY, DOCTOR
8 OF PODIATRY, DOCTOR OF CHIROPRACTIC, LICENSED PHYSICAL
9 THERAPIST, LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER, CERTIFIED REGISTERED
10 NURSE ANESTHETIST, CERTIFIED REGISTERED NURSE PRACTITIONER,
11 CERTIFIED ENTEROSTOMAL THERAPY NURSE, CERTIFIED COMMUNITY HEALTH

12 NURSE, CERTIFIED PSYCHIATRIC MENTAL HEALTH NURSE, CERTIFIED
13 CLINICAL NURSE SPECIALIST, LICENSED PSYCHOLOGIST, LICENSED
14 SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST, LICENSED AUDIOLOGIST OR LICENSED
15 TEACHER OF PERSONS WHO ARE HEARING IMPAIRED.

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17 "PROFESSIONAL HEALTH SERVICES." DENTAL SERVICES, MEDICAL 18 SERVICES, OPTOMETRIC SERVICES, OSTEOPATHIC SERVICES, PODIATRY 19 SERVICES, CHIROPRACTIC SERVICES, PHYSICAL THERAPY SERVICES, 20 CLINICAL SOCIAL WORK SERVICES, PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES, SPEECH-21 LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY SERVICES, AUDIOLOGY SERVICES, SERVICES OF 22 TEACHERS OF PERSONS WHO ARE HEARING IMPAIRED, CERTIFIED 23 REGISTERED NURSE SERVICES PROVIDED BY A CERTIFIED REGISTERED 24 NURSE AT ANY TIME EXCEPT WHEN THE CERTIFIED REGISTERED NURSE IS 25 ACTING AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A HEALTH CARE FACILITY OR OF AN 26 ANESTHESIOLOGY GROUP OR ANY ONE OR MORE OF THEM, PROVIDED ANY OF 27 THE ABOVE-LISTED SERVICES ARE MEDICALLY NECESSARY.

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29 SECTION 2. SECTION 6322(F) OF TITLE 40 IS AMENDED TO READ: 30 § 6322. SCOPE OF SERVICE.

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(F) LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENT OF STATED PURPOSES OF EXISTING
CORPORATIONS.--THE STATED PURPOSES OF ALL EXISTING GENERAL
MEDICAL SERVICE CORPORATIONS ARE HEREBY AMENDED SO AS TO INCLUDE
THE FURNISHING OF OSTEOPATHIC, DENTAL, OPTOMETRIC, PODIATRY,
CHIROPRACTIC, PHYSICAL THERAPY, <u>CLINICAL SOCIAL WORK</u>,
PSYCHOLOGICAL, SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY SERVICES
AND THE SERVICES OF TEACHERS OF PERSONS WHO ARE HEARING IMPAIRED
THROUGH DOCTORS OF OSTEOPATHY, DENTISTRY, OPTOMETRY, PODIATRY
AND CHIROPRACTIC AND THROUGH LICENSED PHYSICAL THERAPISTS,
<u>LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKERS</u>, PSYCHOLOGISTS, SPEECH-LANGUAGE
PATHOLOGISTS, AUDIOLOGISTS AND TEACHERS OF PERSONS WHO ARE
HEARING IMPAIRED, RESPECTIVELY.

14 SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 180 DAYS.
