AN ACT

Amending the act of December 19, 1996 (P.L.1478, No.190), entitled "An act relating to the recycling and reuse of waste 3 tires; providing for the proper disposal of waste tires and the cleanup of stockpiled tires; authorizing investment tax credits for utilizing waste tires; providing remediation grants for the cleanup of tire piles and for pollution 6 7 prevention programs for small business and households; 8 establishing the Small Business and Household Pollution 9 Prevention Program and management standards for small business hazardous waste; providing for a household hazardous 10 waste program and for grant programs; making appropriations; 11 12 and making repeals, " further providing for the Used Tire Pile 13 Remediation Restricted Account; and requiring the Department of Environmental Protection to provide an annual report on 14 15 cleanup of stockpiled tires. 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 17 Section 1. Section 110 of the act of December 19, 1996 18 (P.L.1478, No.190), entitled "An act relating to the recycling 19 20 and reuse of waste tires; providing for the proper disposal of 21 waste tires and the cleanup of stockpiled tires; authorizing 22 investment tax credits for utilizing waste tires; providing remediation grants for the cleanup of tire piles and for 23

- 7 Section 110. Funds.
- 8 (a) Establishment of restricted account.--There is hereby
- 9 established in the General Fund a restricted account to be known
- 10 as the Used Tire Pile Remediation Restricted Account. This
- 11 account shall receive [up to \$1,000,000,] <u>\$3,000,000</u> transferred
- 12 [upon approval of the Governor,] on an annual basis for a period
- 13 [not to exceed] of five consecutive years beginning fiscal year
- 14 2007-2008 through fiscal year 2011-2012 from the Recycling Fund
- 15 created by section 706 of the act of July 28, 1988 (P.L.556,
- 16 No.101), known as the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and
- 17 Waste Reduction Act.
- 18 (b) Appropriation of fund.--
- 19 <u>(1)</u> Moneys in the account are hereby appropriated [upon
- 20 approval of the Governor] to the department for the purposes
- of this act.
- 22 (2) For fiscal year 2007-2008 through fiscal year 2011-
- 23 2012 moneys in the account shall be used for the following
- 24 purposes:
- (i) The remediation of waste tire piles on the
- 26 <u>priority enforcement list maintained by the department</u>
- pursuant to section 107(a) and (b).
- 28 (ii) The remediation of waste tire piles on the list
- of additional waste tire sites maintained by the
- department pursuant to section 107(d).

1 (iii) For the award of grants pursuant to section 111 for remediation of waste tire piles as provided in 2 3 this subsection or for activities authorized by section 111 which the department determines will assist with the 4 5 remediation of waste tire piles as provided in this subsection. 6 7 (3) No more than 5% of the money in the account may be 8 used for the development and implementation of public education and technical assistance programs concerning the 9 management of used tires. 10 (d) Annual report by department. -- As part of its annual 11 budget submission to the General Assembly for fiscal year 2007-12 2008 through fiscal year 2011-2012, the department shall provide 13 a report on the Used Tire Pile Remediation Restricted Account 14 and the remediation of used tire piles. The department shall 15 16 post the report on the department's publicly accessible Internet website. The report shall include: 17 18 (1) The current balance of the account and the projected balance of the account at the end of the fiscal year for 19 20 which the department's budget is being submitted. 21 (2) A listing of waste tire piles remediated or to be remediated pursuant to subsection (b) during the prior fiscal 22 23 year and cumulatively since the effective date of this 2.4 subsection. 25 (3) Those waste tire piles which the department expects to remediate pursuant to subsection (b) during the fiscal 26 27 year for which its budget is being submitted and the 28 projected cost for remediation of those waste tire piles. 29 (4) Those waste tire piles which will remain to be remediated pursuant to subsection (b) and the projected cost 30

- for remediation of those waste tire piles. 1
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
