INTRODUCED BY PICCOLA, ORIE, WAUGH, WONDERLING, CORMAN, GREENLEAF, McILHINNEY, ARMSTRONG, BAKER, BROWNE, SCARNATI, REGOLA AND GORDNER, OCTOBER 25, 2007

AS RE-REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE ON APPROPRIATIONS, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, JUNE 10, 2008

## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, " prohibiting the furlough of 21 Commonwealth employees. 22 DECLARING THE CURRENT ECONOMIC CONDITIONS IN THE COMMONWEALTH AS 23 AN EMERGENCY; RESTRICTING THE FURLOUGH OF STATE EMPLOYEES 24 PRECEDING THE ENACTMENT OF A BUDGET; AND MAKING AN 25 APPROPRIATION AND TRANSFER FROM THE BUDGET STABILIZATION 26 RESERVE FUND.

- 27 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 28 hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 223 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 2 No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by
- 3 adding a subsection to read:
- 4 Section 223. Payday. \* \* \*
- 5 <u>(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if a general</u>
- 6 appropriation act for a fiscal year is not enacted before the
- 7 beginning of that fiscal year, all employes of the Commonwealth
- 8 shall be considered to be critical and essential employes and
- 9 <u>may not be furloughed because of the failure to enact a general</u>
- 10 appropriation act for a fiscal year. No employes of the
- 11 <u>Commonwealth shall be furloughed based on any categorization or</u>
- 12 <u>distinction not expressly provided for in law.</u>
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 14 SECTION 1. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 1703-
- 15 A(B) OF THE ACT OF APRIL 9, 1929 (P.L.343, NO.176), KNOWN AS THE
- 16 FISCAL CODE, PROVIDING FOR THE GOVERNOR TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY
- 17 AND SUBMIT A PROPOSAL REQUESTING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE
- 18 BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS
- 19 AND DECLARES:
- 20 (1) THAT THE ECONOMIC CONDITIONS OCCURRING DURING THE
- 21 2007-2008 SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY CONSTITUTE AN
- 22 EMERGENCY WHICH ENDANGERS THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF
- 23 THE RESIDENTS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH IN NUMEROUS AND DIVERSE
- 24 WAYS WHICH CAN BE ALLEVIATED BY A TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE
- 25 BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 26 (2) THAT THE PRACTICE OF FURLOUGHING ANY STATE EMPLOYEE
- 27 PRECEDING THE ENACTMENT OF A GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT FOR
- 28 FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009, CONSTITUTES AN EMERGENCY THAT WOULD
- 29 ENDANGER THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF
- 30 THIS COMMONWEALTH BY INTERFERING WITH THE ADMINISTRATION OF

- 1 VITAL STATE PROGRAMS AND THAT AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE
- 2 BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND IS NECESSARY TO ALLEVIATE
- 3 THE EMERGENCY.
- 4 SECTION 2. SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 1703-A(B) OF
- 5 THE ACT OF APRIL 9, 1929 (P.L.343, NO.176), KNOWN AS THE FISCAL
- 6 CODE, REQUIRING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THROUGH APPROVAL OF A
- 7 SEPARATE APPROPRIATION BILL BY A VOTE OF TWO-THIRDS OF THE
- 8 MEMBERS ELECTED TO THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 9 TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FROM THE BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND
- 10 TO MEET THE EMERGENCY CAUSED BY THE ECONOMIC CONDITIONS
- 11 OCCURRING DURING THE 2007-2008 SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
- 12 AND AFTER DEDUCTION FOR THE SPECIFIC APPROPRIATION UNDER SECTION
- 13 3, THE REMAINING BALANCE IN THE BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE
- 14 FUND IS HEREBY TRANSFERRED TO THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE FISCAL
- 15 YEAR JULY 1, 2008, TO JUNE 30, 2009, FOR APPROPRIATION FOR
- 16 VARIOUS PURPOSES TO MEET THE EMERGENCY UNDER SECTION 1(1).
- 17 SECTION 3. SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 1703-A(B) OF
- 18 THE ACT OF APRIL 9, 1929 (P.L.343, NO.176), KNOWN AS THE FISCAL
- 19 CODE REQUIRING THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THROUGH APPROVAL OF A
- 20 SEPARATE APPROPRIATION BILL BY A VOTE OF TWO-THIRDS OF THE
- 21 MEMBERS ELECTED TO THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 22 TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FROM THE BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND
- 23 TO MEET THE EMERGENCY AND THAT ANY UNEXPENDED MONEY APPROPRIATED
- 24 ACCORDING TO SECTION 1703-A(B) LAPSE INTO THE BUDGET
- 25 STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND, THE SUM OF \$20,000,000, OR AS MUCH
- 26 THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED FROM THE
- 27 BUDGET STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1,
- 28 2008, TO JUNE 30, 2009, SOLELY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SALARIES,
- 29 BENEFITS AND EXPENSES OF THOSE STATE EMPLOYEES HIRED ON OR
- 30 BEFORE JUNE 30, 2008, WHO WOULD BE SUBJECT TO FURLOUGH EXCEPT

- 1 FOR THE PROVISION OF THIS ACT.
- 2 SECTION 4. THE APPROPRIATION IN SECTION 3 SHALL NOT BE
- 3 EXPENDED FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OR ADMINISTRATION OF ANY NEW
- 4 PROGRAMS. UPON THE ENACTMENT OF THE GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT
- 5 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009, THE APPROPRIATION IN SECTION 3 SHALL
- 6 EXPIRE AND ANY UNEXPENDED MONEYS SHALL LAPSE INTO THE BUDGET
- 7 STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND.
- 8 SECTION 5. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
