AN ACT

Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing, in provisions 3 relating to the Governor and disaster emergencies, for 4 general authority of the Governor. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 7301(f)(8) of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection SUBSECTIONS to read: § 7301. General authority of Governor. 10 11 12 (f) Additional powers. -- In addition to any other powers conferred upon the Governor by law, the Governor may: 13 14 15 (8) Suspend or limit the sale, dispensing or

transportation of alcoholic beverages, [firearms,] explosives

- 2 (g) Construction. Nothing in this section shall be

- 6 AND AMMUNITION. -- NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE
- 7 CONTRARY, A LAWFULLY POSSESSED FIREARM, FIREARM ACCESSORY OR
- 8 AMMUNITION SHALL NOT BE CONFISCATED, SEIZED OR FORFEITED UNLESS
- 9 SUCH CONFISCATION, SEIZURE OR FORFEITURE WOULD BE AUTHORIZED IF
- 10 AN EMERGENCY DID NOT EXIST.
- 11 (H) DEFINITIONS.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING
- 12 WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS
- 13 **SUBSECTION:**
- 14 "ACCESSORY." ANY SCOPE, SIGHT, BIPOD, SLING, LIGHT,
- 15 MAGAZINE, CLIP OR OTHER RELATED ITEM THAT IS ATTACHED TO OR
- 16 <u>NECESSARY FOR THE OPERATION OF A FIREARM.</u>
- 17 <u>"FIREARM." THE TERM INCLUDES ANY WEAPON THAT IS DESIGNED TO</u>
- 18 OR MAY READILY BE CONVERTED TO EXPEL ANY PROJECTILE BY THE
- 19 ACTION OF AN EXPLOSIVE OR THE FRAME OR RECEIVER OF ANY WEAPON.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
