12	(5) Notwithstanding section 306 (relating to liability
13	for conduct of another; complicity) or any other statute to
14	the contrary, any person, licensed importer, licensed dealer
15	or licensed manufacturer who knowingly and intentionally
16	sells, delivers or transfers a firearm in violation of this
17	chapter [who has reason to believe that the firearm is
18	intended to be used in the commission of a crime or attempt

to commit a crime shall be criminally liable for such crime
or attempted crime.] shall be criminally liable for any crime
<u>or attempted crime in which the firearm is used.</u>

(6) Notwithstanding any act or statute to the contrary, 4 5 any person, licensed importer, licensed manufacturer or licensed dealer who knowingly and intentionally sells or 6 7 delivers a firearm in violation of this chapter [who has reason to believe that the firearm is intended to be used in 8 the commission of a crime or attempt to commit a crime] shall 9 10 be liable in the amount of the civil judgment for injuries suffered by any person [so injured by such crime or attempted 11 12 crime.] who is injured during any crime or attempted crime in 13 which the firearm is used.
