AN ACT

- 1 Amending Titles 24 (Education) and 71 (State Government) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for
- 3 supplemental annuities commencing 2008.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 8348.8. Supplemental annuities commencing 2008.
- 9 (a) Benefits. -- Commencing with the first monthly annuity
- 10 payment after July 1, 2008, and annually thereafter, any
- 11 eligible benefit recipient shall be entitled to receive further
- 12 additional monthly supplemental annuities from the system. These
- 13 shall be in addition to the supplemental annuities provided for
- 14 in sections 8348 (relating to supplemental annuities), 8348.1
- 15 (relating to additional supplemental annuities), 8348.2
- 16 (relating to further additional supplemental annuities), 8348.3
- 17 (relating to supplemental annuities commencing 1994), 8348.4
- 18 (relating to special supplemental postretirement adjustment),

- 1 8348.5 (relating to supplemental annuities commencing 1998),
- 2 8348.6 (relating to supplemental annuities commencing 2002) and
- 3 8348.7 (relating to supplemental annuities commencing 2003).
- 4 (b) Amounts of supplemental annuities. -- Beginning July 1,
- 5 2008, and annually thereafter, the amounts of the supplemental
- 6 annuities payable pursuant to this section shall be calculated
- 7 by applying the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index
- 8 for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New
- 9 <u>Jersey</u>, <u>Delaware and Maryland area</u>, for the most recent 12-month
- 10 period for which figures have been officially reported by the
- 11 <u>United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics</u>,
- 12 immediately prior to the date the adjustment is due to take
- 13 effect, to the then-current annuity amount.
- 14 (c) Payment.--The supplemental annuity provided under this
- 15 <u>section shall be paid automatically unless the annuitant files a</u>
- 16 written notice with the board requesting that the additional
- 17 monthly supplemental annuity not be paid.
- 18 (d) Conditions.--The supplemental annuity provided for under
- 19 this section shall be payable under the same terms and
- 20 <u>conditions as provided under the option plan in effect as of</u>
- 21 <u>July 1, 2008.</u>
- 22 (e) Benefits to beneficiaries or survivors.--No supplemental
- 23 annuity provided under this section shall be payable to the
- 24 <u>beneficiary or survivor annuitant of a member who dies before</u>
- 25 <u>July 1, 2008.</u>
- 26 (f) Funding.--The additional liability for the increase in
- 27 benefits provided by this section shall be funded in equal
- 28 <u>dollar annual installments over a period of ten years beginning</u>
- 29 <u>July 1, 2009.</u>
- 30 (g) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "eligible

- 1 benefit recipient means a person who is receiving a
- 2 <u>superannuation</u>, withdrawal or disability annuity on July 2,
- 3 2008.
- 4 Section 2. Title 71 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 5 § 5708.9. Supplemental annuities commencing 2008.
- 6 (a) Benefits.--Commencing with the first monthly annuity
- 7 payment after July 1, 2008, and annually thereafter, any
- 8 eligible benefit recipient shall be entitled to receive a
- 9 <u>supplemental monthly annuity from the system. This shall be in</u>
- 10 addition to the supplemental annuities provided for in sections
- 11 5708 (relating to supplemental annuities), 5708.1 (relating to
- 12 <u>additional supplemental annuities</u>), 5708.2 (relating to further
- 13 <u>additional supplemental annuities</u>), 5708.3 (relating to
- 14 supplemental annuities commencing 1994), 5708.5 (relating to
- 15 supplemental annuities commencing 1998), 5708.6 (relating to
- 16 supplemental annuities commencing 2002), 5708.7 (relating to
- 17 supplemental annuities commencing 2003), and the special
- 18 supplemental postretirement adjustment provided for in sections
- 19 5708.4 (relating to special supplemental postretirement
- 20 adjustment) and 5708.8 (relating to special supplemental
- 21 postretirement adjustment of 2002).
- 22 (b) Amounts of supplemental annuities. -- Beginning July 1,
- 23 2008, and annually thereafter, the amounts of the supplemental
- 24 <u>annuities payable pursuant to this section shall be calculated</u>
- 25 by applying the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index
- 26 for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New
- 27 Jersey, Delaware and Maryland area, for the most recent 12-month
- 28 period for which figures have been officially reported by the
- 29 <u>United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics,</u>
- 30 immediately prior to the date the adjustment is due to take

- 1 <u>effect</u>, to the then-current annuity amount.
- 2 (c) Payment. -- The supplemental annuity provided under this
- 3 section shall be paid automatically unless the annuitant files a
- 4 <u>written notice with the board requesting that the additional</u>
- 5 monthly supplemental annuity not be paid.
- 6 (d) Conditions. -- The supplemental annuity provided for under
- 7 this section shall be payable under the same terms and
- 8 conditions as provided under the option plan in effect as of
- 9 July 1, 2008.
- 10 (e) Benefits to beneficiaries or survivors. -- No supplemental
- 11 annuity provided for under this section shall be payable to the
- 12 <u>beneficiary or survivor annuitant of a member who dies before</u>
- 13 July 1, 2008.
- 14 (f) Funding.--The additional liability for the increase in
- 15 benefits provided by this section shall be funded in equal
- 16 <u>dollar annual installments over a period of ten years beginning</u>
- 17 July 1, 2009.
- 18 (q) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "eligible
- 19 benefit recipient means a person who is receiving a
- 20 superannuation, withdrawal or disability annuity on July 2,
- 21 2008.
- 22 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
