- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for exceptional 6 children, education and training. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. - 12 Section 1372. Exceptional Children; Education and

- 14 (9) Burden of Proof and Time Limitations Relating to
- 15 Exceptional Children.
- 16 (i) In all proceedings related to the provision of a free
- appropriate public education for exceptional children, including 17
- whether children are being educated in the least restrictive 18
- environment, the local educational agency responsible for 19

- 1 providing education to the student with disabilities shall have
- 2 the burden of proof, the burden of production and the burden of
- 3 persuasion in any such proceeding, except with respect to any
- 4 <u>determination of the appropriateness of any private school</u>
- 5 placement unilaterally selected by a parent or quardian, the
- 6 <u>burden of proof, production and persuasion shall rest upon the</u>
- 7 student, the student's parent or the student's quardian.
- 8 (ii) School districts and intermediate units that seek to
- 9 <u>evaluate a child under IDEA must complete the evaluation within</u>
- 10 sixty (60) calendar days of receipt of permission from the
- 11 parent or guardian to perform the evaluation.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
