AN ACT

- Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2
- Statutes, further providing for Auditor General's reports.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 4
- 5 Section 1. Title 4 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes
- 6 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 1214. Auditor General's reports.
- 8 In cooperation with the department and the State Treasurer,
- the Auditor General shall annually audit and report on the
- 10 amounts and uses of the distributions made under Chapter 14
- (relating to revenues) from the State Gaming Fund and the 11
- 12 Pennsylvania Gaming Economic Development and Tourism Fund. In
- 13 addition, every four years, the Auditor General shall perform an
- 14 internal audit of the expenses and revenues of the board. In
- addition to examining the agency's financial statements, the 15
- 16 Auditor General shall be entitled to examine original source
- 17 documents at such times as is believed necessary, or may

- 1 <u>otherwise examine original documents on a random basis designed</u>
- 2 to ensure the integrity of the audit. The audit shall include,
- 3 <u>but not be limited to, the expenses incurred by individual</u>
- 4 members of the board and reimbursed or otherwise paid for by the
- 5 board. The Auditor General shall prepare a written report of its
- 6 audits under this section and submit a copy of the report to the
- 7 <u>Community, Economic and Recreational Development Committee of</u>
- 8 the Senate and the Gaming Oversight Committee of the House of
- 9 Representatives no later than April 1 of each year.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
