14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Section 4 of the act of September 30, 1983
16	(P.L.160, No.39), known as the Public Official Compensation Law,
17	is amended by adding a subsection to read:
18	Section 4. Members of the General Assembly.
19	(e) Suspension of annual cost-of-living adjustment during
20	recessionNotwithstanding any other provision of this act or
21	law to the contrary, the annual cost-of-living adjustment for
22	members, officers and leaders of the General Assembly as
23	provided under subsections (d) and (d.1) shall be suspended and

1	may not be paid during any time period in which the Chief Clerk
2	of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of
3	Representatives jointly determine that there have been two
4	consecutive calendar quarters of negative growth in the gross
5	domestic product of the United States. The Chief Clerk of the
6	Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives shall
7	jointly publish a notice in the Pennsylvania Bulletin when such
8	time period commences and shall jointly publish an additional
9	notice in the Pennsylvania Bulletin when such time period
10	terminates.
11	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
