A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of April 22 through 28, 2007, as
- 2 "Pennsylvania One Call System Week."
- 3 WHEREAS, As excavators and contractors work to keep pace with
- 4 this Commonwealth's unprecedented economic development, it is
- 5 important to minimize damage to underground utility lines,
- 6 danger to workers, loss of utility service to our citizens and
- 7 environmental pollution; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania One Call System, a utility service
- 9 information center celebrating its 35th anniversary of
- 10 continuous service to this Commonwealth, is key to preventing
- 11 injuries and damage when digging; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania One Call System provides easy, one-call
- 13 notification about construction and excavation projects that may
- 14 endanger workers and jeopardize utility lines while also
- 15 promoting public safety, reducing underground utility damages,
- 16 minimizing utility service interruptions and protecting the

- 2 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania One Call System began with six utility
- 3 companies in western Pennsylvania and the City of Pittsburgh and
- 4 now serves more than 100,000 excavators and 3,100 critical
- 5 infrastructure owners in this Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania One Call System transmits more than 6
- 7 million notifications to protect critical infrastructure owners
- 8 in this Commonwealth each year; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of April 22
- 10 through 28, 2007, as "Pennsylvania One Call System Week" and
- 11 encourage all residents of this Commonwealth to call 1-800-242-
- 12 1776 at least three working days and not more than ten working
- 13 days before digging in order to protect underground utility
- 14 lines.
