A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the 25th anniversary of the dedication of the
2 Vietnam Veterans Memorial.

3 WHEREAS, The Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C.,
4 celebrates the 25th anniversary of its dedication in 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, The memorial commemorates the sacrifice of more than
6 58,000 men and women who lost their lives during the Vietnam
7 War; and

8 WHEREAS, The memorial honors the sacrifice of the 153,303 men
9 and women who were wounded during the war; and

10 WHEREAS, The memorial honors the more than 3,000,000 men and
11 women who served in the United States Armed Forces in Southeast
12 Asia; and

13 WHEREAS, The memorial has served as a powerful force for
14 national healing; and

15 WHEREAS, More than 4,000,000 people visit the memorial each

1 year to pay tribute to lost loved ones and remember the
2 sacrifice of those who served the United States during the
3 Vietnam War; and

4 WHEREAS, The memorial is a testament to the dedication of the
5 private individuals and corporations that raised \$8,400,000 to
6 build the memorial; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Senate of Pennsylvania commemorate the
8 25th anniversary of the dedication of the Vietnam Veterans
9 Memorial; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the Senate of Pennsylvania recognize the
11 service of the men and women who were members of the United
12 States Armed Forces during the Vietnam War and honor the
13 sacrifice of the men and women who lost their lives during the
14 Vietnam War.
