AN ACT

- 1 Establishing a grant program and a fund to assist individuals in
- paying for continuation of health insurance; and conferring
- powers and duties on the Insurance Department.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Health
- 8 Insurance Continuation Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "COBRA coverage." Insurance coverage under Title 1 Subtitle
- 14 B Pt. 6 of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974
- 15 (Public Law 93-406, 29 U.S.C. § 1161 et seq.).
- 16 "Department." The Insurance Department of the Commonwealth.
- 17 "Fund." The Health Insurance Continuation Fund established
- 18 in section 4.
- 19 Section 3. Administration.

- 1 (a) Powers. -- The department has the following powers:
- 2 (1) Determine eligibility for grants under section 5(b)
- 3 (2).
- 4 (2) Promulgate regulations to implement this act.
- 5 (b) Duties. -- The department has the following duties:
- 6 (1) Use the fund under section 4(d).
- 7 (2) Provide forms under section 5(b)(1).
- 8 (3) Issue grants under section 5(b)(2)(i).
- 9 Section 4. Fund.
- 10 (a) Establishment. -- The Health Insurance Continuation Fund
- 11 is established as a separate fund in the State Treasury.
- 12 (b) Purpose. -- The purpose of the fund is to assist
- 13 individuals in paying for COBRA coverage.
- 14 (c) Source. -- The following are the sources of the fund:
- 15 (1) Appropriations.
- 16 (2) Return on money in the fund.
- 17 (d) Use. -- The department shall use the fund to issue grants
- 18 under section 5(b)(2)(i).
- 19 (e) Nonlapse. -- The money in the fund is continually
- 20 appropriated into the fund. This appropriation shall not lapse
- 21 at the end of any fiscal year.
- 22 Section 5. Grants.
- 23 (a) Eligibility. -- An individual is eligible for a grant
- 24 under this section if all of the following apply:
- 25 (1) No other person is responsible for, or is providing
- for, the individual's health insurance coverage.
- 27 (2) The individual is receiving benefits under the act
- of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1),
- known as the Unemployment Compensation Law.
- 30 (3) The individual's prorated weekly premium for COBRA

- 1 coverage exceeds 10% of the individual's weekly income from
- 2 unemployment compensation benefits and severance pay.
- 3 (b) Procedure.--
- 4 (1) An applicant must apply to the department for a grant on a form provided by the department.
- 6 (2) Within 30 days of submission of the form under
 7 paragraph (1), the department shall take one of the following
 8 actions:
- 9 (i) If it determines the applicant eligible under 10 subsection (a), issue the grant.
- 11 (ii) If it determines the applicant ineligible under 12 subsection (a), deny the grant.
- 13 (3) Failure to comply with the time requirement of 14 paragraph (2) shall be deemed a denial of the grant.
- 15 (4) A denial under paragraph (2)(ii) or (3) is subject 16 to 2 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 Subch A. (relating to judicial review of 17 Commonwealth agency action).
- 18 Section 20. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
