1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for accidents involving death or personal injury.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3742 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.
9	(a) General ruleThe driver of any vehicle involved in an
10	accident resulting in injury or death of any person shall
11	immediately stop the vehicle at the scene of the accident or as
12	close thereto as possible but shall then forthwith return to and
13	in every event shall remain at the scene of the accident until
14	he has fulfilled the requirements of section 3744 (relating to
15	duty to give information and render aid). Every stop shall be
16	made without obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

1 (b) Penalties.--

2 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any
3 person violating this section commits a misdemeanor of the
4 first degree.

5 If the victim suffers serious bodily injury, any (2) 6 person violating subsection (a) commits a felony of the 7 {third} second degree, and the sentencing court shall order 8 the person to serve a minimum term of imprisonment of not 9 less than 90 days and a mandatory minimum fine of \$1,000, 10 notwithstanding any other provision of law. AN ADDITIONAL 11 FINE AND TERM OF IMPRISONMENT UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE 12 IMPOSED FOR EACH VICTIM.

(3) If the victim dies, any person violating subsection
(a) commits a felony of the [third] <u>second</u> degree, and the
sentencing court shall order the person to serve a minimum
term of imprisonment of not less than one year and a
mandatory minimum fine of \$2,500, notwithstanding any other
provision of law. <u>AN ADDITIONAL FINE AND TERM OF IMPRISONMENT</u>
UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IMPOSED FOR EACH VICTIM.

20 (B.1) ENHANCED PENALTIES.--

21 (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, ANY 22 PERSON VIOLATING THIS SECTION CONCURRENTLY WITH A VIOLATION OF SECTION 3802 (RELATING TO DRIVING UNDER INFLUENCE OF 23 24 ALCOHOL OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE) AND WHO IS CONVICTED OF 25 VIOLATING SECTION 3802 COMMITS A FELONY OF THE THIRD DEGREE. 26 (2) IF THE VICTIM SUFFERS SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, ANY 27 PERSON VIOLATING SUBSECTION (A) CONCURRENTLY WITH A VIOLATION OF SECTION 3802 AND WHO IS CONVICTED OF VIOLATING SECTION 28 29 3802 COMMITS A FELONY OF THE SECOND DEGREE, AND THE SENTENCING COURT SHALL ORDER THE PERSON TO SERVE A MINIMUM 30

<u>TERM OF IMPRISONMENT OF NOT LESS THAN ONE YEAR AND TO PAY A</u>
 <u>MANDATORY FINE OF \$2,500, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION</u>
 <u>OF LAW. AN ADDITIONAL FINE AND TERM OF IMPRISONMENT UNDER</u>
 <u>THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE IMPOSED FOR EACH VICTIM.</u>

(3) IF THE VICTIM DIES, ANY PERSON VIOLATING SUBSECTION 5 (A) CONCURRENTLY WITH A VIOLATION OF SECTION 3802 AND WHO IS 6 7 CONVICTED OF VIOLATING SECTION 3802 COMMITS A FELONY OF THE 8 SECOND DEGREE, AND THE SENTENCING COURT SHALL ORDER THE 9 PERSON TO SERVE A MINIMUM TERM OF IMPRISONMENT OF NOT LESS THAN THREE YEARS AND TO PAY A MANDATORY FINE OF \$5,000, 10 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW. AN ADDITIONAL 11 12 FINE AND TERM OF IMPRISONMENT UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE 13 IMPOSED FOR EACH VICTIM.

14 Authority of sentencing court. -- There shall be no (C) 15 authority in any court to impose on an offender to which this 16 section is applicable any lesser sentence than provided for in 17 subsection (b) (2) or (3) OR (B.1) (2) OR (3) or to place such 18 offender on probation or to suspend sentence. Sentencing 19 guidelines promulgated by the Pennsylvania Commission on 20 Sentencing shall not supersede the mandatory sentences provided 21 in this section.

(d) Definitions.--As used in this section, the term "serious bodily injury" means any bodily injury which creates a substantial risk of death or which causes serious, permanent disfigurement or protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ.
